

## Lefebvrite bishop to appeal fine

British Lefebvrite Bishop Richard Williamson who was fined \$16,822 in Germany for denying the Holocaust is appealing the fine, The [Associated Press has reported](#) [1].

The AP quotes Williamsno's lawyer, Matthias Lossmann, as saying that Williamson "objected to the fine, which means there will be a trial."

Williamson is one of four traditionalist Society of St. Pius X bishops rehabilitated by Pope Benedict XVI in January.

The Vatican is in the midst of [twice-a-month meetings](#) [2] with the Society of St. Pius X folks. Vatican officials have called the talks "cordial, respectful and constructive."
