

Pallottine priest recalls work with Cardinal Jorge Bergoglio

Over at the Catholic Apostolate Center is [an interview with Irish Pallottine priest Derry Murphy](#) [1], who worked in Buenos Aires, Argentina, from 1985-2002 and with Cardinal Jorge Bergoglio, now Pope Francis.

The [Catholic Apostolate Center](#) [2] is a new evangelization Web-based platform under the direction of my friend Pallottine [Fr. Frank Donio](#) [3] and is a ministry of the Society of the Catholic Apostolate (commonly known as the Pallottines), which takes its inspiration from the spirituality of [St. Vincent Pallotti](#) [4].

Five Pallottines -- three priests, a professed student and a postulant -- were killed in the parish house in Belgrano on July 4, 1976, during the military dictatorship.
