**Update:** The \$1,000 matching grant was met at 10:57 a.m. central time.

Thanks for the endorsement, Craig. I have mentioned several times this week that the kind of reporting *NCR* provides does not come cheap. Few things of quality are free. Someone has to foot the bill. This is your chance to help pay the price.

Yet we know not everyone is of equal means. In fact, only in rare occasions has *NCR*'s Web presence been locked behind a pay wall. Much of the reason for that is we want to be accessible to people of even meager means. We know many people in our readership live near or below the poverty line. Some do this by choice; others do not have the choice.

I received an email from a person who -- as much as he would like to -- cannot afford a monetary donation to *NCR* at this time. He is a priest in mission territory serving among the very poor. He said he can't send money, but he said he will celebrate 15 Masses for the intention of *NCR* in the month of May.

We never turn down prayers. Thank you, Father.
