I recently discovered it in St. Patrick's Church in Oakland, California. It has been around for [awhile](#) [1], but after six months of Pope Francis, it deserves repeating.

We extend a special welcome to those who are single, married, divorced, gay, filthy rich, dirt poor, *yo no hablo inglés*. We extend a special welcome to those who are crying newborns, skinny as a rail or could afford to lose a few pounds. We welcome you if you can sing like Andrea Bocelli or like our pastor who can't carry a note in a bucket. You're welcome here if you're "just browsing," just woke up or just got out of jail. We don't care if you're more Catholic than the Pope, or haven't been in church since little Joey's Baptism.
