A [disgraced cardinal's archdiocese in Scotland will be subject to a Vatican investigation](#) [1]. Bishop Charles Scicluna will be there April 8-10 to "listen to and report the testimony offered by past and present members of the clergy ... concerning any incidents of sexual misconduct committed against them by other members of the clergy whomsoever."

Speaking of sexual misconduct, the crisis is the [worst crisis to hit the U.S. church](#) [2] in the 20th century, writes Fr. Tom Reese in his column.

Meanwhile in Texas, [a serial killer was executed](#) [10] the state's new drug supply.

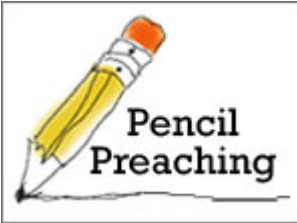
Egypt: [Bombings bring escalation in campus wars](#) [11]. Universities have emerged as the main centers of protests.
